Thank you for your interest in participating in the Native American House Alliance Pow Wow. Reproductions or machine made products are discouraged – exceptions are clothing and blankets. This is, historically, culturally and traditionally, a Native American event and your cooperation is appreciated.

1. Tables only at booth space. NO RV, trailers of any kind can be allowed on site. This is an outdoor event at an historically significant state park in an urban setting – please come prepared.
2. Vendor must provide their own tables, chairs and canopies.
3. Vendor is allowed to sell Native American House Alliance Pow Wow items.
4. No electricity provided.
5. Drugs, alcohol, firearms, fireworks and/or weapons of any kind ARE NOT ALLOWED.
6. Only Service Dogs are allowed onsite.
7. Space is assigned for one day from 8am to 6pm only. Space is assigned as paid for at the discretion of NAHA.
8. We have no parking permit.
9. Off-loading begins on Sunday at 8 AM on a first-come first-served basis.
10. Off-loading ends at 8pm on Sunday.
11. ONLY Authorized food vendors will sell food.
12. Selection will be chosen by the Pow Wow Committee.
13. Sales can take place ONLY in booths in which a booth fee has been paid. Walk arounds are not authorized unless approved by Committee.
14. Reasonable competitive prices only – Price wars are not allowed.
15. FULL payment is required prior to registration and set-up. Please INCLUDE money order, or paypal nahaincphila@gmail.com, **50% to save your space please send with vendor application by August 30, 2022.**
16. Information booths are NOT allowed to make any sales.
17. NAHA is in full support of the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990, please click on link to read the law <https://www.doi.gov/iacb/act>.
18. Non-adherence to these guidelines may require cancellation of Vendor agreement.
